Carver Fire Relief Association



Two firemen discussed increases in fire relief benefits with the council at the November 2nd meeting. The mayor explained past history and funds were low, as well as interest due to retirements. Fire Relief would like to work with council to make future increases a smooth progression. Representatives will gather numbers and return to the council.



Public Works Report

Frey reported the cost to repair bathrooms at Riverside Park. Estimated total cost of project would be about \$ 1,000. An estimate of all aspects of work was requested.



Council discussed construction of an addition to the Fire Station for public works. The DNR had been contacted and construction of structure would have to be elevated above flood stage. It was the council's consensus that the staff actively pursue construction of an addition to the Fire Station.

Municipal Utilities



Hook-up on Elm Drive to sewer and water has not been repaired adequately. Staff was directed to forward a letter with due date for repair or the repairs would be made and billed to property owners.

Letter was discussed regarding processes required prior to certification for water treatment plant.

Property Purchase



Council considered purchase of property on Broadway to rent Carver County HRA (Housing Redevelopment Authority). Council would like to see numbers on cost of the building and remodeling. Statement was made that if staff did most of the work, it may not be too expensive. Administrator was directed to proceed with negotiations with the HRA for a lease agreement and purchase of the building.

Miscellaneous



Council reviewed 1992's resolution regarding fees. Revisions were made. The updated resolution will be resubmitted for approval at the December meeting.

Changes have been made to the Employment Agreement with the Administrator.

Mayor has forwarded letters to Senators and Representatives for appointment of Chad Peterson to the Naval Academy.

Discussion was also presented that the recodification process should be resumed soon.

Comprehensive Plans



Request for proposal have been narrowed down and administrator spoke with the Planning Commission about requests for proposals. General consensus at this point was that the Comprehensive Plan could be done for less than proposals between the Planning Commission, Administrator and Planner since the Administrator has had experience with Comprehensive Plans.

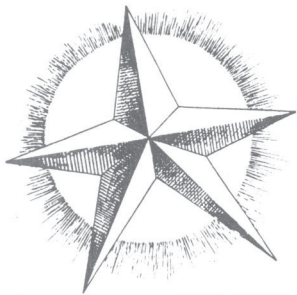
