



Speeding



On February 1st, 1993 the council discussed complaint received regarding speeding between Diedrich Drive and Broadway. Sign, "Slow-Children" are posted both at the top and the bottom of the hill and speed limit signs are posted both places. Question was asked about a seasonal "Stop" sign at Fourth and Ash. It was decided that the Sheriff's Department would check into the situation first.



1994 Township Fire Agreements

Dahlgren and San Francisco Township Board members were present to discuss 1994 fire rates. Dahlgren's Chairman informed the council of a three year contract with the City of Cologne which expires in 1993. The township requested a reduction in 1994 rates but no change was made.

The Townships also requested that the City of Carver meet with the City of Cologne and townships served by the two cities for fire protection. Request was made to attempt to set one rate being paid by both cities and try to negotiate a multi-year contract. The mayor favored meeting with the City of Cologne and the townships of Dahlgren, San Francisco, Benton and Hancock to discuss fire rates.

Park and Recreation Board



The council reviewed thank you letters for services on the Park and Recreation Board. Motion was made and carried appointing Craig Hanson, Ken Frey, Jr and Mark Chalupsky to the Park and Recreation Board for two year terms.



Historic Preservation Commission

Motion was made and carried appointing Brian Kemkes, Pam Larson, Robin Kashuba and Cindy Monroe to two year terms on the Heritage Preservation Commission.

Council was told of Heritage Preservation's efforts to set guidelines, inviting the council's input for the project. Council was also told of Heritage Preservation's favoring vacating land in front of the house on Sixth Street.

Riverside Park

Carver County forwarded a letter regarding the burn site in Riverside Park. The letter dealt with the issue of necessity for site to be closed and cleaned up. Frey assured council clean-up would be completed in spring. Mayor requested letter be sent to county confirming action to clean up and schedule date for completion, tentative date of May 1st, weather permitting.

Sixth Street

Letter was received from Soil Conservation Office describing conditions of the grant on drainage control on Sixth Street. Project object was to slow water coming down the hill. Mayor requested to see plans that had been drawn up in the past.



Planning Commission

Motion was made and carried reappointing Sandee Haerden and Ralph Bailey to the Planning Commission.

Miscellaneous

Motion was made and carried adopting resolution establishing a *Values Week*, February 21st through February 27th.

Council reviewed an Emergency Plan coordinating resources with the City of Carver and Carver County. Chapters One and Two of City Ordinances were reviewed for recodification.

The mayor talked about taping council meetings for cable television. Response was mixed regarding the issue.
