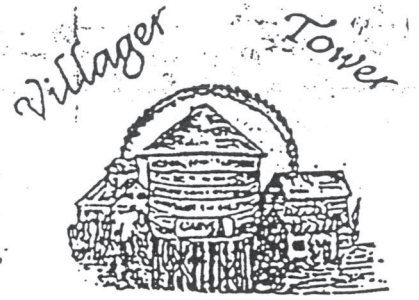

Public Works Report

Public Works Director presented request to purchase a bobcat. The council discussed the issue. Motion was made to authorize purchase of bobcat.

Community Development

Motion was made and carried by roll call vote adopting resolution supporting the 1999 Metro Greenways Planning Grant application sponsored by Carver County.

Motion was made and carried by roll call vote adopting a resolution that determined that an Environmental Impact statement was not necessary for the proposed Carver Cafe Demolition project.

Public Planning Advisory

Mayor reported that Mike Webb resigned from the Planning Commission. There would have been three council members on the board which is not allowed. Another council member inquired about members being on various boards as voting members. Attorney stated that other cities do not allow this practice either, especially in the smaller communities. Replacement ad would be placed in "Carver Quarterly".

Municipal Utilities

Phone read meters are being added to the municipal utilities system. Council member inquired about how to aid in expediting this process to eliminate the two days it takes reading meters. Two council members volunteered to help install these meters.

Safety equipment purchase of tripod required by OSHA was discussed by the council. Motion was made to authorize purchase.

Financing of wastewater treatment plant issues were discussed. Staff and engineer were authorized to research plans and financing alternatives to present at a later meeting.

Carver Bluffs

The Engineer explained items to the council regarding Carver Bluffs Second Addition Plat. The entrance monuments were discussed as well. The developer inquired about a date change on the Developer's Agreement. The council found the request reasonable. There was some discussion concerning street names. Moving of heavy equipment was requested since the size of this equipment was a concern to some residents.

Street Lights

The Council discussed the item regarding putting up street lights at County Road #147 at Sixth Street and Highway #212. These lights could be served by either NSP or MN Valley Electric. These lights would be an offset since two lights are being removed at Riverside Park. Motion was made and carried to install two light poles on County Road #147 at Sixth Street and Highway #212.

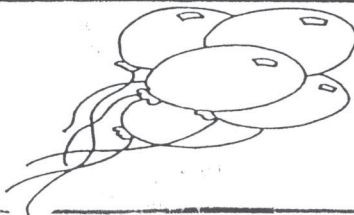
Miscellaneous

The council briefly discussed four-way Stop signs on Sixth Street and County Road #147. This proposal has been presented to the county. The idea would probably not be feasible.

Spring Creek Erosion

Property owner was present at the council meeting to discuss erosion occurring at Spring Creek. The property owner had received a quote for repairs since erosion is affecting his own property but he was not in complete agreement that financial responsibility was his alone. Background work from the past was presented to the council. City attorney is to look into the issue, as well as the engineer. This issue is to be discussed again at a later date.

Mr Hope Cemetery

The monthly cost of maintenance services at the cemetery has increased. Approval of contract was requested. One council member suggested that headstones not be allowed except at ground level. Grave site increase in price was discussed. Putting the service out for bid was also talked about. Administrator was directed to research alternatives.
