Another council member inquired about members being on various boards as voting members. Attorney stated that other cities do not allow this practice either, especially in the smaller communities. Replacement ad would be placed in "Carver Quarterly".

Municipal Utilities

Phone read meters are being added to the municipal utilities system. Council member inquired about how to aid in expediting this process to eliminate the two days it takes reading meters. Two council members volunteered to help install these meters.

Safety equipment purchase of tripod required by OSHA was discussed by the council. Motion was made to authorize purchase.

Financing of wastewater treatment plant issues were discussed. Staff and engineer were authorized to research plans and financing alternates to present at a later meeting.

CARVER Bluffs

The Engineer explained items to the council regarding Carver Bluffs Second Addition Plat. The entrance monuments were discussed as well. The developer inquired about a date change on the Developer's Agreement. The council found the request reasonable. There was some discussion concerning street names. Moving of heavy equipment was requested since the size of this equipment was a concern to some residents.

Mill Styles

The Council discussed the item regarding putting up street lights at County Road #147 at Sixth Street and Highway #212. These lights could be served by either NSP or MN Valley Electric. These lights would be an offset since two lights are being removed at Riverside Park. Motion was made and carried to install two light poles on County Road #147 at Sixth Street and Highway #212.


Miscellaneous




