Mike is the son of Denny and Cindy Dauwalter of Carver, MN. He grew up in Carver and graduated from Chaska Senior High School. He married Jessica Root on June 18, 2011 and bought a home in Cologne where they've lived for the past 6 years. He is self-employed operating under "Mike Dauwalter Construction".

Mike was diagnosed on July 3, 2013 with inoperable lung cancer and has metastasis to the pericardial fluid, which is excess fluid around his heart. Tuesday July 16th he had a PET and MRI scan which showed no further cancer cells in any other organs of his body. On July 22nd he started aggressive chemotherapy treatment which requires him to have a week of therapy, Monday through Friday, and then has two weeks off. This therapy will continue for a total of 4 sessions and then the plan of care will be re-evaluated.

Another CT scan was done on Aug. 6th. This scan showed the excess fluid around the heart has been resolved. It also showed the tumor on his right lung had not shrunk but it had not grown either. Good news!
